Issue, Description & Background The Strengthening, Preserving and Reunifying Families ("SPRF") Program was created by the Oregon legislature with the goal of reducing trauma to children who are removed from their families of origin because of reasons of abuse or neglect, and to resolve those issues by means of offering family-focused services. The overall goals of Marion County Transitional Treatment and Recovery Community Services are to support Child Welfare and differential response to families (SPRF) with the support of community based services, that result in the safe and equitable reduction of children in the foster care system. DHS established the original IGA; #145988 In July 2014 with a period of performance through June 30, 2017. The State is issuing a new IGA #154316 to continue these services for a one year period of performance; July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018.

Financial Impacts: The IGA provides \$235,000 in incoming funds for the term through June 30, 2018.

Impacts to Department & External Agencies The Health Department anticipates no impacts to other departments.
