TITLE Solid Waste Management Advisory Council (SWMAC) Member Reappointment

Issue, Description & Background The Marion County Board of Commissioners formed the Solid Waste Management Advisory Council (SWMAC) on February 1, 1989, as a public body to provide them with advice and recommendations. The council membership consists of eight citizen-at-large positions and eight from business and industry. The county's policy and SWMAC bylaws require the board of commissioners make the final membership appointments. Bonnie Sullivan has served on the SWMAC as the building/construction industry representative for twelve years. Her input on matters of solid waste has been extremely valuable to the council. She has served as the chair for various subcommittees, has donated much of her time to assuring that the council's bylaws and handbook are up-to-date, and helped in electing and mentoring new members. Ms. Sullivan has agreed to serve an additional four year term on the council so she is before the board for reappointment.

Options for Consideration: 1. Accept the reappointment as recommended by SWMAC. 2. Do not accept the reappointment and direct staff to search for another individual to fill this position on the SWMAC.

Recommendation: It is recommended that the board of commissioners approve the reappointment of Bonnie Sullivan for a four-year term on the Solid Waste Management Advisory Council in the building/construction industry position, beginning July 1, 2018 through July ?, 2022.

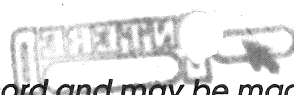
