TITLE Re-Appointment of Zachary Diehl and Mark Grenz to the Marion Water Quality Advisory Committee.

Issue, Description & Background The Marion County Board of Commissioners formed the Marion Water Quality Advisory Committee (MWQAC) on July 28, 2010. The committee membership consists of six citizen-at-large positions and five positions from construction, development, agricultural, and watershed council. The terms of the individual positions are for four-year terms. The MWQAC is a public body, which under their by-laws makes recommendations to the board of commissioners. The county's policy and the MWQAC by-laws require that the board of commissioners make the final appointments. The terms of the individual appointments are four years. Zachary Diehl and Mark Grenz dedicated their service to the county on this committee since its inception and the department is requesting their re-appointment.

Options for Consideration: 1. Accept the re-appointments. 2. Do not accept this re-appointments and direct staff to search for other individuals to fill these positions on the MWQAC.

Recommendation: It is recommended that the board of commissioners approve the re-appointment of Zachary Diehl and Mark Grenz for four-year terms on the Marion Water Quality Advisory Committee beginning October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2022.
