TITLE Bridgeway Recovery Services (BRS)- Jail - Re-Entry Amendment #1

Issue, Description & Background Bridgeway provides re-entry and prison diversion services that include mental health assessment and treatment, education, anger and self management and problem solving skills. The goal of this program is to increase employability, pro-social behavior, enhanced pro-social motivation and support and treatment completion and aftercare.

Financial Impacts: The purpose of this amendment is to add funds for year 2 of the biennium. The availability of funds was dependent on the legislative adopted budgets.

Subject: Bridgeway Recovery Services – Jail Re-Entry _ Amendment #1

The Marion County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) contracts with Bridgeway Recovery Services to provide re-entry and prison diversion services that include mental health assessments and treatment, education, anger and self management and problem solving skills. The goal of this program is to increase employability, pro-social behavior, enhanced pro-social motivation and support, treatment completion and aftercare.

The possibility of this amendment was dependant on the availability of funds resulting from the legislative adopted budgets and the results of expenditures in the first year of the biennium such as, FTE benefits and costs, union contract settlements and the availability of remaining funds.

As an exception, the Sheriff's Office would like to amend this agreement through the end of the biennium for \$ 173,144.00, more than 20% of the original contracted amount. The services provided under this contract will remain the same.

AMENDMENT # 1 to the
CONTRACT FOR SERVICES
between

MARION COUNTY and BRIDGEWAY RECOVERY SERVICES

This Amendment No. 1 to the Contract for Services (as amended from time to time, the "Contract"), dated July 1, 2017 between Marion County, a political subdivision of the State of Oregon, hereafter called County, and Bridgeway Recovery Services, hereafter called Contractor.

The Contract is hereby amended as follows (new language is indicated by underlining and deleted language is indicated by brackets):

1. TERM. This Contract becomes effective on July 1, 2017 and expires on June 30, 2019 [June 30, 2018].

2. CONSIDERATION.

A. The maximum, not-to-exceed compensation payable to Contractor under this Contract, which includes any allowable expenses, is \$338,722.00 [\$165,578.00].

**EXHIBIT A
STATEMENT OF WORK**

2. COMPENSATION. The total amount available for payment to Contractor under Exhibit A, section 2.A and for authorized reimbursement to Contractor under Exhibit A, section 2.C is \$338,722.00 [\$165,578.00].

A. METHOD OF PAYMENT FOR SERVICES.

County shall pay Contractor \$14,428.67 [\$13,798.00] per month up to but not in excess of \$338,722.00 [\$165,578.00] for completing all Services required under this Contract.

Except as expressly amended above, all other terms and conditions of the original contract are still in full force and effect. Contractor certifies that the representations, warranties and certifications contained in the original Contract are true and correct as of the effective date of this Amendment and with the same effect as though made at the time of this Amendment.
