# WHAT IS A MENTAL HEALTH CRISIS?

# WHAT IS THE YOUTH CRISIS TEAM AND HOW CAN THEY HELP?

The youth crisis team consists of two therapists who will provide crisis assessments and intervention in the home, school, and community. The team will provide a collaborative coordination of care focusing on stabilization and safety in your home.
