Community Resource Network

The Community Resource Network (CRN) connects resources to people by putting organizations in touch with each other to easily share information about extra resources, seek help with unmet needs, or develop community-wide service oriented events.

The CRN is free and any organization (public body, nonprofit, and for-profit) registered to do business in the state of Oregon is eligible to become a member. The CRN complements the 211 system, which helps organizations and community members find services and supports.

- CRN members log on to the network in order to post or review requests.
- Requests are sent to other members via email.
- Members control what type of requests they receive, based on the categories selected within their profile.
