A YEAR IN REVIEW

TRASHY TUESDAY - Marion County led a group of dedicated volunteers to clean over 150 lbs of trash from our waterways

RECYCLING - Marion County adapted to the major changes in the recycling markets and managed to rank 3rd in the state for recovery of recyclable materials

WATER QUALITY - Marion County staff attended 20 events to promote watershed health to students and the public

EARTHWISE - The EarthWISE program certified 6 new businesses and welcomed a new EarthWISE program coordinator.

NOXIOUS WEEDS - Received a \$25,000 grant from ODA to prevent noxious weeds along the Upper Mill Creek and Salem Ditch

WASTE REDUCTION - Received a \$75,000 grant from DEQ to install milk dispensers and reusable dishes in Marion County Schools

PARKS - Marion County's Parks completed major improvement projects at 4 different parks and smaller improvement projects at 7 other parks. The MC parks and trails in the North Fork Corridor had record attendance, selling over 8,800 parking passes

POLICY CHANGES - Saw the City of Salem pass a plastic bag ban that will go into effect April 1st, 2019
