How to Obtain Dust Abatement 2021

- Customers fill out the Lignin permit and send applications to Marion County approved Contractors. NOTE: (Approved Contractors are listed on the application permit.)
- 2. Customer calls the approved Contractor to schedule the work.
- 3. Selected Contractors WILL stake areas and mark road sections as needed. Roads must be clearly staked to identify start and stop points of application sites.
- 4. Contractor MUST forward permit applications to Marion County via scanned email or fax.
- 5. Marion County reviews/approves permits and then returns approved permits to Contractors via scanned email or fax.
- 6. Contractor must notify Marion County of their intended schedule within 2 business days.
- 7. Marion County will proceed to grade the staked areas per the approved permit and WILL notify the Contractor if grading cannot be completed by the approved scheduled time of the Contractor.
- 8. Contractor applies dust control product to road surface per the approved permit.*

^{*}Application shall be centered on the gravel road. If the road is less than 16' in width, the entire road shall be shot (berm to berm). If the road is over 16' in width, the minimum width of application is 16'.
