PROCLAMATION

This matter came before the Marion County Board of Commissioners at its regularly scheduled meeting on May 12, 2021, to proclaim May as Foster Care Month in Marion County.

WHEREAS, many children in our community must be temporarily removed from their homes to ensure that the child's physical and emotional needs are addressed, and

WHEREAS, there are numerous individuals in public and private organizations, the courts, and in the faith-based community who work to support the foster care system and recruit foster families, and

WHEREAS, May has been designated National Foster Care Month and this year's theme is "Foster Care as a Support to Families, Not a Substitute for Parents" which highlights the importance of supporting parents in need, and honoring the critical role of foster parents in keeping families together;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Marion County Board of Commissioners asks everyone to join together to thank individuals and families that provide support, affection, love, and security to the children in their care, as well as those organizations and agencies that support foster families and proclaim the month of May as:
