Issue, Description & Background		Joel Conder has been a member of the Marion County Fair Board since 2013. He has had various responsibilities on the board including Fair Board Chair. Most recently he has been the fair's National Acts point person. Joel is desiring to be reappointed to the Marion County Fair Board.					
		Colleen Busch was appointed as a Key Volunteer in 2020. She has been ready and willing to serve the fair in general areas wherever she is needed.					
		Rebecca Turner was appointed as a Key Volunteer in 2020. She has served the fair in the area of Public Competitions and most recently has become the Public Competitions Coordinator for the fair.					
		Since Joel, Colleen, and Rebecca are all interested in continuing on the fair board for another term and have the skills and talents needed, the Fair Board requests that the Board of Commissioners reappoint Joel Conder, as a fair board member, and Colleen Busch and Rebecca Turner as Key Volunteers, to the Marion County Fair Board with a term ending date of December 31, 2025.
