lssue, Description & Background	The Marion County Board of Commissioners formed the Solid Waste Management Advisory Council (SWMAC) on February 1, 1989. The council membership consists of eight citizen-at-large positions and eight from business and industry. The terms of the individual positions are for four-year terms.				
	The SWMAC is a public body, which, under their bylaws, makes recommendations to the Marion County Board of Commissioners. The County's policy and the SWMAC bylaws require that the Marion County Board of Commissioners make the final appointments.				
	At a SWMAC meeting held on September 28, 2021, the Council voted to move Brian Sund from the position of Citizen-at-Large position to vice-chair. Brian has served on the Council since 2007.
