This matter came before the Marion County Board of Commissioners at its regularly scheduled meeting of May 14, 2025; and
WHEREAS, Oregon Revised Statute 215.050 authorizes the governing body to revise the zoning ordinances; and
WHEREAS, Sections 16.38.010 and 17.110.840 of the Marion County Code authorize the Board of Commissioners to initiate legislative amendments to the text of the zoning code; and
WHEREAS, a Battery Energy Storage System is a use that is not explicitly contemplated in the county zoning code; and
WHEREAS, the Marion County Board of Commissioners has determined that consideration of zoning code amendments related to this use are in the general public interest; now therefore,
BE IT RESOLVED that the Marion County Board of Commissioners hereby initiates consideration of amendments to Chapters 16 and 17 of the Marion County Code; and
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board hereby directs the Marion County Planning Director to schedule a public hearing to receive testimony on the proposed amendments before the Board of Commissioners and provide notice of the hearing.
