Approve Amendment #18 to the incoming funds Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Health Authority to decrease funding for Program Element (PE) 36-01, OSTPR (Opioid Settlement Prevention, Treatment, and Recovery), Board Primary Prevention Funding, in the amount of \$625,874 for a new contract total of \$16,616,712.84 through June 30, 2025.
