HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES

2. Approve a Contract for Services with Tania C. Bailey, dba, Sabia Mental Health LLC, in the not-to-exceed amount of \$667,000 to provide skilled medical assessment and Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner (PMHNP) services to individuals receiving mental health services at Marion County Health and Human Services (MCHHS) through June 30, 2028.
