BUSINESS SERVICES

1. Approve the Public Improvement Agreement with TraneOregon in the amount of \$888,835 for the replacement of ten Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning (HVAC) roof top units and four HVAC heat recovery units at the Marion County Juvenile Detention Center through December 31, 2026.

2. Approve Amendment #6 to the Contract for Services with Advanced Security Inc. to add \$1,650,000 for a new not-to-exceed contract total of \$3,450,000 to continue to provide unarmed security, vehicular patrol, and walking patrol services at multiple Marion County Health and Human Services (MCHH) locations through December 31, 2028.

3. Approve Amendment #1 to the Interdepartmental Agreement (IDA) with the Marion County District Attorney's Office to add \$126,000 for a new not-to-exceed IDA total of \$230,594 to continue to provide one 0.7 Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Deputy District Attorney Three (DDA3) to manage mental health cases including but not limited to aid and assist cases for the Marion County Health and Human Services (MCHHS) Jail Diversion Program through June 30, 2027.
