				Oregon Health Authority (OHA) contracts with Marion County Health Department to operate and contract services for the operation of Public Health Services in accordance with the policies, procedures and administrative rules of the OHA. OHA shall distribute the financial assistance award for Program Elements to the Health Department in substantially equal monthly payments July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2019 unless otherwise specified.
