- Replace Silverton Middle School
 - o New building attached to existing gymnasium, secure main entry, ADA accessibility
 - o Remodel gym, locker rooms
 - o Demolish buildings, abate asbestos and hazardous material
- Construct new K-8 School
 - o Consolidate Pratum, Evergreen, Central Howell schools
- Upgrade school facilities
 - o Repair, replace, add, or update roofs, plumbing, exteriors, flooring, windows, electrical/generators, HVAC
 - o Upgrade science instruction classrooms
 - o Enhance ADA accessibility
- Security
 - o Upgrade alarm systems, cameras
 - o Communication system and electronic access
- Site improvements, furnishings, equipment, bond issuance costs.

Citizen oversight committee would be established to ensure proceeds used for purposes indicated. Audits required.

Bonds may be issued in multiple series maturing within 26 years from issuance. The bond tax rate is estimated to remain at the FY 2026 rate of \$1.88 per \$1,000 of assessed value. Actual levy rate may differ due to actual interest rates, changes in assessed value.
