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### **WHAT IS A MENTAL HEALTH CRISIS?**

Youth experiencing mental health crisis may experience intense feelings of distress, change in functioning, catastrophic life events and may or may not be of danger to self/others.

### **WHAT IS THE YOUTH CRISIS TEAM AND HOW CAN THEY HELP?**

The youth crisis team consists of two therapists who will provide crisis assessments and intervention in the home, school, and community. The team will provide a collaborative coordination of care focusing on stabilization and safety in your home.

### **WHAT HAPPENS WHEN I CALL?**

A therapist will offer you immediate help to stabilize the crisis and determine if the crisis team needs to go to your home. Therapist can assist in referral process when needed.
