Recommendations for Community Cafés

1. Identify people to attend VIRTUAL Community Café Host Training being organized by FHI.
2. Invite community leaders to attend the training.
 - a. Include organizational staff, CSOCs, parents, and students.
 - b. Enlist help from CSOCs and others to determine good candidates.
 - c. Ask people who already have relationships with prospective attendees to invite them.
3. Schedule Community Café Host Training at the best time for parents.
 - a. Hold workshops in the evening over three consecutive weeks
 - b. Friday, 6:00-7:30 pm, October 16, 23, 30
4. Compensate parents for their time attending the training.
 - a. Provide dinner for families (send them a gift card, have pizza delivered, etc)
 - b. Possibly offer an additional stipend for the training time
5. Use the training to plan the content of the first Community Café listening session for the neighborhood.
