

Transitional Shelter Loans

The shelter facilities must be located in Marion County. It must provide benefit to low-income individuals or families in Marion County, but outside the city limits of Salem.

Zero percent, deferred payment loans

- o Construct new transitional shelter facilities.
- Purchase existing properties for transitional shelter.
- Modifications to a property to convert it to a transitional shelter.
- The loan remains as a lien on the property until the property is sold or transferred to a different party.

Available to purchase or construct, or operate a transitional shelter in Marion County

• HUD definition of Non-Congregate Shelter (NCS) -

"NCS provides private units or rooms as temporary shelter to individuals and families and do not require occupants to sign a lease or occupancy agreement."

 In addition to creating new transitional shelters, operating expenses for new facilities can also be covered for a period of time.
