- ➤ Update on Legislative Activity
 - o Decisions are being made very quickly
 - o HB 365 CCO's
 - Proposals went out late January
 - Applications are due Mid March
 - CCO's will start July 1
 - The Hospital and WVP Health Authority are working together
 - Anticipate services to stay the same for about a year and then the CCO will take over the care for an individual
 - Outcome measure will be key CCO's will be paid based on performance
 - o The budget is anticipating a cut in the 15% range for the general fund

Review and Discussion:

- ➤ Senior Sub-Committee Update
 - Worked on Bulleting information. Working to identify the most important subjects we want to address
 - What Speakers
 - 2 tracks 1 professional and 1 general public
 - There are not a lot of services available looking to do a pilot project with some possible funding
 - o Would like to present the white paper to the Governors Commission
 - Would like to incorporate gambling, but there needs to be some more research done first.

Enhanced Detox Amendment:

- > Status of the enhanced detox amendment with Bridgeway
 - AMH awarded preliminary amendments to the contracts. They had to resubmit their budget because the grant doesn't support funds for remodeling or major medical equipment
 - They are waiting for the money to be released. It will be just under \$500,000. The money will come through Marion County and into Bridgeway.
 - o Bridgeway is hopeful to have the money and start medical detox in April
 - o Mark has some people that might be able to help with the renovations.
