ABOUT EARLY CHILDHOOD NURSING

Our ECN program provides home visiting services to pregnant women and children (ages 0-21) who meet eligibility guidelines. The service is offered at no cost to families.

ECN nurses can help answer your health questions, teach you how to understand and care for your child, and show you how to encourage and support your child's growth and development.

We can also assist with referrals to community resources to help meet your family goals.

You and your nurse work together to make a plan for home visiting services that best fit your schedule and needs.

The program is voluntary and available to families residing in Marion County.

Our staff can provide bilingual service in Spanish and arrange for interpretation in other languages.

ECN SERVICES
