



Overlooked Pool Maintenance:



Emergency Phone – Make sure your emergency phone still works. The address of the pool facility should also be posted in the pool area.



Posted Rules – Verify that you have a current version of the Pool and Spa rules posted.



Poor Test Kit Care – Ensure reagents are used prior to their expiration date. Colored reagents and those in brown bottles usually have shorter shelf lives. Remember to keep test kits out of direct sunlight and never store with chemicals.

Flowmeters



A working flow meter must be installed and located where it is easily readable. This will help you verify that enough water is recirculating through the piping to meet the required turnover rate. And remember: **If the float doesn't move, your inspector won't approve.**

Skimmer Where?



Pool skimmers help remove trash, debris, and other items from the top surface of the water.

L2 FLOW

Having issues keeping the skimmer weirs in place?

Then you may find it beneficial to install screw-in skimmer weirs or skimmer baskets.
