Details for your poster:

- Artwork needs to be on letter-sized (8½-by-11), white paper in landscape orientation (hot dog style.)
- It can not include a winning hand or a winning combination of symbols. That can cause problems for some people who struggle with problem gambling.
- No violence, drugs, alcohol, or illegal activity should be shown.
- We cannot accept art that is copyrighted.
- If you use a computer to create art, you must draw by hand (no clip art, etc.)
- **Please remember to spread a message of hope!!!**
