Transferable Skills

A transferrable skill is anything you can do that is not specific to a particular role; examples include teamwork, leadership, work under pressure, achieving timelines, etc.

E = Evidence you possess it (Example of when you used that skill)

E = Explain how it ties back to the job you are interviewing for
