## <u>Volunteer Opportunity:</u> Local Alcohol and Drug Planning Committee Seeking New Members

The Marion County Board of Commissioners and the Marion County Health and Human Services Department are accepting applications from community members interested in serving on the Marion County Local Alcohol and Drug Planning Committee (LADPC). The LADPC serves as the local planning committee for alcohol and drug prevention and treatment services in Marion County.

When making appointments to the LADPC the Board of Commissioners will consider applicants who provide broad geographic representation, who have expertise in areas such as developing prevention, treatment, and education programs, or who have lived experience related to addiction and addiction services.

The LADPC meet in Salem on the 1<sup>st</sup> Thursday of every month, from 8:30am-10:00am. Applicants must be 18 years of age, and live or work in Marion County to be eligible for appointment to the LADPC.
